4. Collecting papers: by 15<sup>th</sup> September 2016.
5. Double blind peer revision of papers: from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2016 to 2<sup>nd</sup> Jan 2017.
6. Sending revisions to authors: by 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2017.
7. Collecting corrected papers: by 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2017.
8. Editing: from 3<sup>rd</sup> April to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2017.
9. Sending papers to authors for proof-reading: by 10<sup>th</sup> July 2017.
10. Collecting final versions of papers: by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017.
11. Publishing the volume: from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 29<sup>th</sup> October 2017.
12. Distributing copies: from 3<sup>rd</sup> November to 30<sup>th</sup> December 2017.
